Leadership of the School of Art, Design and Creative Industries, 2017-present

Leadership and Management. In this role, I oversee 16 faculty and staff, up to 15 adjuncts per semester (teaching 29-30 courses, 12-15 graduate assistants, and 6-8 student workers. Departments within the school include Art Education, Art History, Graphic Design, and Studio Art. We serve around 250 majors and 600 non-major students within the university.

Financial Management and Budget. I work with an approximate \$1.8 million dollar budget within the school. My focus is on fiscal responsibility, proper budgeting, and forward-thinking planning regarding the financial management of the school. During my tenure, I have been able to maintain and expand positions within the school regarding growth areas. We have replaced aging equipment in all areas and expanded the capabilities of both ceramics and sculpture.

Facilities Improvements. I oversee four buildings on the campus of Wichita State University, McKnight Art Center which is made up of three buildings, McKnight East, West and North, and Henrion Hall, made up of two basketball gymnasiums and the bleacher section of a football stadium. When I became director of the school, all our facilities were in need of major repairs and renovations. Working closely with the College of Fine Arts Dean and University Facility Planning, I have been able to get numerous repairs/renovations completed, including:

- * 2017-2018 replacement of McKnight atrium skylight and all other skylights in the building to stop persistent leaks.
- * 2019 complete remodeling of newly acquired space in Henrion Hall to make three new graduate studios and a graduate critique space.
- * 2019-2020 completely renovate ceramics area in Henrion Hall, bringing critical ventilation up to current health and safety requirements. Project cost was approximately \$1.2 million.
- * 2021-2022 renovate and upgrade sculpture wax room and ceramic shell room, bringing critical ventilation up to current health and safety requirements. We also expanded the outdoor foundry space and fence, creating a more efficient and welcoming space for students. Project cost was approximately \$1 million.

- * 2023-present we are currently working to design and then renovate the printmaking facilities in McKnight North. This renovation will once again bring critical ventilation up to current health and safety requirements. It will also create a more efficient workflow for the students and faculty. Project cost projected to be \$2.3 million.
- * 2024-present we are currently working on extensive HVAC renovations in Henrion Hall. This project will bring air conditioning to all of Henrion Hall, update more graduate studios and create a new wood shop for student use.

Curriculum. Moving into the interim director role in 2016, I was a member of a four-person team to develop curriculum for the Bachelor of Applied Arts in Media Arts. On this team, I played a critical role in developing not only the overall curriculum, but complete development of the Game Design and Animation tracks. My direct contributions to the degree were:

- * a core curriculum that all students take to emphasize the interdisciplinarity of the tracks.
- * a 15 credit elective unit allowing students to focus on other professional and technical skills.
- * a professional practice sequence of classes to help students better understand the industry they will enter upon graduation.
- * a progressive practicum sequence for students to get involved in structured, collaborative projects. This sequence allows them to learn about all aspects of relevant projects gaining valuable applied learning opportunities.

Once developed, I helped shepherd the program through the Wichita State Faculty Senate and the Kansas Board of Regents approval processes. The degree is housed in a newly formed School of Digital Arts. Since its inception, the school/program has been very successful growing to be the largest school in the College of Fine Arts with almost 400 majors.

Accreditation. The School of Art, Design and Creative Industries is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASAD). As director, I oversaw a successful comprehensive site review in 2019, board approval of the BAA in Media Arts degree tracks under NASAD's purview and brought us closer to full institutional membership with the health and safety repairs to our facilities (full membership should be achieved with completion of the printmaking renovation).

Inclusive Excellence for all students. As a first generation and Pell eligible student myself, I feel like I understand and can relate to the struggles of these two critical groups of students in today's educational environment. As director, I have worked hard to be available and help all students succeed in their educational endeavors. Highlights of my work include:

- * receiving a Tilford Grant in 2012 for my *100 Hours of Design* project where graphic design students and local professional designers worked with minority non-profits along the 21st Street corridor to advance their missions.
- * supporting a diverse range of visiting artists through the various programs put on by the school through the Clayton Staples Gallery, ShiftSpace Gallery, the Art History Awards and others.
- * creating a Diversity, Equity and Inclusion task force within the school which included mandatory training for all faculty and staff.
- * regularly advising 40-60 undergraduate students per semester to plan their degree progress and encourage them in their efforts to graduate.
- * participating in 8-10 summer orientation sessions, talking with students and parents about success in college.

Fundraising and Development. I regularly work with our pooled donor group to fund raise for the school. I have also been involved with fundraising efforts involving several donors.

- * I received a Faculty Fundraising Award from the Wichita State Foundation for my involvement with a \$15 million estate plan gift.
- * I have been involved with the securing of a \$1 million estate gift for scholarships within the school, a \$225,000 estate gift for development and a \$25,000 gift for visiting artists.

Service. As can be seen in my CV below, I am very active through service to the university at all levels. This work has given me the opportunity to understand the needs of other units and allowed me to advocate for the fine arts within the larger university setting.
